GENERAL INFORMATION

Often a strong wind blows, sometimes gusts on the terrace, in this case please do not leave objects on the table or in the garden. The awning retracts itself.

So also please push the grill behind the house in strong winds.

In each room there are remote controls for air conditioning, when operating please close windows.

In the bathrooms there are remote controls for the ceiling lamps, Bluetooth speakers are integrated.



In the children's room is also a ceiling lamp with dimmer etc. and Bluetooth speaker for good night stories. Also the kitchenette has a remote control for individual lighting.



In the white bedroom you can regulate the light with the app AwoX Smart Control. TV with international satellite, and antenna connection.

In the storeroom you will find towels and bathrobes at your disposal, as well as the washing machine. Stores, banks, post office, bakery, cafes 500m at the traffic circle down to the right,

Supermarkets such as Plodine and Lidl can be reached by car in 5 minutes, also down the traffic circle.

<u>Pula – 43 km</u>

Coastal town at the tip of the Croatian peninsula of Istria, is known for its protected harbor, numerous beaches and ruins from the Roman period. The city area was settled already in prehistoric times. In the course of history Pula was occupied, destroyed and strategic location, Pula has been occupied, destroyed and rebuilt several times. Both the Romans and the Ostrogoths, the Venetians and the Allies in World War 2 once ruled in the city. Beautiful pedestrian zone with numerous stores and cafes, large morning market

<u>Rovinj – 55km</u>

Rovinj is a Croatian port town on the west coast of the Istrian peninsula. The old town, whose houses are densely packed along the waterfront, is located on a promontory. Winding, cobblestone streets lead up to the hilltop church of St. Euphemia, with its high tower. whose high spire dominates the townscape. South of the old town is the bay of Lone, one of the numerous pebble beaches in the region. Just off the mainland are the 14 islands of the Rovinj archipelago. Picturesque old town, considered the most beautiful town on the west coast.

Porec – 66km

Poreč is a popular summer resort on the coast of the Istrian peninsula in western Croatia. The 6th-century Euphrasius Basilica is located in the historic old town and is famous for its gem-studded Byzantine mosaics. The coastal areas to the north and south of the city offer campsites, marinas and beaches with water sports facilities, which and attract numerous visitors. The Baredine stalactite cave is located about 6 km inland. inland. Spacious harbor promenade.

Brijuni Archipel 35 km

The Brijuni archipelago (ital. "Brioni") stretches along the southwest coast. It lies directly in front of the historical coastal town of Pula. From these places you can reach the island archipelago very well by

ferry.

The 36 km² national park includes 14 islands. The largest of the islands, Veli Brijun has

hotel facilities and a large animal enclosure. This island is free to visit, while the other islands are partly state and privately owned and guarded.

Since 1947 the Yugoslav leader Tito had his favorite summer residence on the island.

summer residence. The luxury resort was accessible only to a select few.

Tito received a large number of leading statesmen and celebrities from the film business, such as Willy Brandt, Sophia Loren, Liz Taylor and Ho Chi Minh.

Tito loved animals, so many international guests brought him exotic animals such as Indian cattle, tigers,

lions, lizards, zebra's and elephants and other animals.

as gifts, for which he created a safari park, which still exists today.

Also the dark green Cadillac Eldorado, which he received from the then

American President Dwight Eisenhower, can still be rented for a short round trip.

After Tito's death (1980) the islands were declared a national park and since 1985 the island is open to

the public. Visitors will be overwhelmed by the beautiful scenery. The

furthermore, numerous events and recreational opportunities are offered.

largest island of Croatia reachable via Brestova by ferry (crossing every 1 - 2 hours takes about 20 min), bays, picturesque harbor town, numerous bays

<u>Opatjia – 47 km above Labin</u>

Opatija is located in the north of the Kvarna Bay, in the immediate vicinity of the metropolis of Rijeka.

The beginnings of tourism began in the 19th century when Opatija became a winter health resort for the

high society of the Austrian aristocracy. In this period were also built

many local residences and villas, which in the course of the last decades were renovated and turned into hotels and boarding houses of high standard.

Opatija, due to its excellent tourist offer and its numerous

sights is also known as the "Nice of Croatia". Beautiful long coastal promenade - Lungomare.

The Church of St. James in the center of Opatija

is one of the most significant buildings in the town. The history of Opatija is closely connected with this church

and its monastery, as both were the namesakes of the town (Opatija is the Croatian word for abbey).

<u> Rijeka – 64 kmRijeka – 64 km</u>

The metropolis of Rijeka, with 144,000 inhabitants is located in the north of the region. Rijeka is an

important commercial center and one of the most important transportation hubs in Croatia.

Thanks to its ideal geographic location, this city has developed into one of the largest ports in this part of Europe since the 19th century.

largest port cities in this part of Europe. Rijeka was also one of the financial centers in the former Yugoslavia.

The well-developed ferry network connects Rijeka with the rest of the coastal towns and islands along

the Adriatic coast.

Besides the Trsat castle, many magnificent facades adorn Rijeka. In the

beautiful, small old town

is the pedestrian zone Korzo with numerous stores. On the waterfront promenade there are

good restaurants and café's (Slastičarnica Cacao, by the harbor), as well as a large market with a large

fish market.

on the other side of the road you can take a hiking trail (rather for experienced) down to Rabac past the waterfalls of Pecina. approx. 40 min Behind Sveta Marina there is a hiking trail to Ravni the first 2 km through forest then only along bays and the sea along the sea, about 2 hours Otherwise numerous hiking trails along the coast and at Ripenda Kosi


